DEFINITIONS

A **family** is classed as comprising a maximum of 2 adults accompanied and a maximum of 7 children up to their 21st birthday. It is not mandatory that the insured persons are related to each other or live in the same household.

If an insured person is traveling alone, the insured sum is 50% of the agreed amount of insurance for the family.

If more than 6 persons or, in the case of family tariffs, more than 2 families have booked a trip together, only the relatives of the insured person shall apply as risk persons, not all insured persons among one another.

Insured persons are:

- insured persons who have booked and insured a trip together between one another.
- the relatives of an insured person; these shall include spouses or civil partners, children, parents, adopted children, adoptive parents, foster children, foster parents, step-children, step-parents, grandparents, siblings, grandchildren, parents-in-law, children-in-law and siblings-in-law, aunts, uncles, nephews and nieces.
- persons that are looking after minor-age or care-dependent relatives of an insured person that are not on the trip.
